The 1st Tesla Club LA Photo Scavenger Hunt

Thank you for joining us for our inaugural TeslaClubLA Photo Scavenger Hunt. We have planned lots of out of this world fun as we all team up and compete with each other for mystery prizes.



You have been assigned a mission to travel this quadrant of the universe and record images and send them back to red planet mission control for scoring. Your pictures need to be posted on the TeslaClubLA Facebook page for points. The pictures must contain ALL of your team members, your TeslaClubLA sign and your team's number / name card (the only



exceptions are listed in the clues). This means you will have to find someone or something to take the pictures for you with your camera at each location. If you post a picture on Facebook without all of the required elements you will not get points for that clue.

The journey clues are listed in traveling order to minimize your energy consumption (23 miles total) but they do NOT have to be completed sequentially. Next to each clue is the estimated time for the task and the travel distance from the previous task. This is a test of puzzle solving and time management skills. You are welcome to have a passenger use the web browser in your Model S' or a smart phone to help you find the answers along the way. If you cannot figure out or find a clue you can continue on to the next one but will lose the listed point value. At many locations there are opportunities for bonus points. Use these to catch up if you're behind. The Quest will end promptly at 4:30pm. The team that arrives first to the final destination will not be given extra points but will be the first to receive a splashy club welcome. This is not a race, but cutoff time for totaling points is 4:30 PM when the Facebook images are tallied and returned bonus items are added to the total. The team that has the highest overall score wins the Quest. We want you to have fun, but please do not drive illegally or take anything without permission. See you in the landing zone!

(In an emergency, you may call Jason at 323-xxx-xxxx but you may forfeit your points and not be eligible to win the Hunt)



The Quest

Clue #1 2 points 2 minutes 0 miles Completed

You've got everything in the world you need to win the Quest. The first thing you need to do is come up with a space-themed creative team name and write it on your team card. Then everyone must write their name on the team card and come to us so we can take a group picture of you with your camera. Remember that every picture throughout the Hunt MUST have EVERY team member in it with the TeslaClubLA sign and team number sign clearly visible. When you post your picture to the TeslaClubLA Facebook page you get your first two points.

Clue #2 4 points 5 minutes .1 miles Completed

Blastoff! Nikola shares his name with this nearby building where it all started. Here is where you had to go to buy and service your Roadster. Head over on foot or strap on your rocket pack if you like, it's up to you. Your task is to take a picture of your team with the company logo on the building. Don't forget that the TeslaClubLA sign and team number sign must also be in the picture.

Bonus Clue 2 points Completed

This is your first opportunity to return with gathered artifacts from your journey. Nearby you can pick up an original Battlestar Galactica Viper pilot branded item and bring it back to the finish for two credits.

Clue #3 4 points 10 minutes 3 miles Completed

Zoom back to your cars and head to the city of the future. This "city" was created on the backlot of 20th Century Fox. Inside the "100 year city" is a mall where you can buy a Tesla or a cupcake. Find a Tesla in the parking lot that does NOT belong to anyone on your team and snap a picture of your group with it for four points.

Bonus Clue 2 points Completed

There once was a man named Nick. No one understood how he ticked. He crafted a rotor and invented a motor and Edison's ass he did kick. Write the name of their epic quarrel on your envelope.

Clue #4 6 points 10 minutes 0 miles Completed

While you're shopping in the "city" rumor has it that you can spot a Model X. Be warned that it only appears for a few seconds every 10 minutes. If you can get a picture of your group with the Model X you will be stars.

Clue #5 4 points 5 minutes 0 miles Completed

The Tesla Superchargers have powered Model S' enough to travel to the moon and back 20 times! (over 10 million miles.) Snap a shot of your group with a standard Tesla branded charger and you will get another 4 points. Have you been remembering to include all of the things needed in your photos and posting them to the TeslaClubLA Facebook page? If not, Houston, we have a problem...

Clue #6 4 points 5 minutes 0 miles Completed

Get a picture of an Edison wall outlet with everyone pointing at it with their right foot.

Clue #7 4 points 15 minutes 3 miles Completed

Back into your transporters! This time in head towards the setting sun. Your Tesla uses the most advanced automobile energy storage system on the planet. Fool Cell EVs are a Shell game that is always 10 years away. Park one of the team cars for your group shot at this "Hindenberg" filling station.

Clue #8 4 points 20 minutes 4 miles Completed

Keep following the lowering sun and head to the city where EV's can park free at street meters. Rumor has it that you can find a Model S "skateboard" at a store there. Premade to the location and get a picture of your team all touching the "skateboard" with both hands.

Bonus clue 4 points Completed

Recreate this picture. Only the TeslaClubLA and team sign must appear in the picture (not your team members). It can be any Tesla of any color and the car can face any direction.



Clue #9 **3 points** **2 minutes** **0 miles** **Completed**

A meteor from space killed the dinosaurs just so their juice could power vintage ICE vehicles. There are floral monuments to their contributions nearby. Photo bomb one for a nostalgic 3 points.

Clue #10 **4-8 points** **5 minutes** **.1 miles** **Completed**

A major fruit company has been said to be interested in Tesla's technology. Stand in the fruit store with your Tesla apps on and showing to the photographer to get 4 points. You get one extra point for every app displaying the start up red screen with the white Tesla "T" logo in the picture for a maximum of 8 points.

Bonus Clue 2 points **Completed**

Another Space retrieval Quest. This time mission control has asked for you to bring home a branded Jonny SpaceX item for examination.

Clue #11 **4 points** **20 minutes** **5 miles** **Completed**

Zip back into your cars and take off. Recreate this vintage picture at this location with the addition of your team members and signage.



Bonus clue 4 points **Completed**

Post a shot of the back hatch of a Model S open with the entire team laying in the back ready for launch. Don't forget your signage!

How are you doing for time? Remember this is a quest for points that ends at a specific time. Calculate wisely.

Clue #12 9 points 35 minutes 2.5 miles Completed

Take off to Eddy Grant's EV anthem. Such a place exists on this earth just a few miles away. Get a passenger to take a picture while driving by of the song-title sign and the galaxy is yours. Only the sign needs to be in the picture for this clue.

Clue #13 6 points 20 minutes 5 miles Completed

Stay in your ship and use a popular EV app on your phone or the equivalent website to drive to the location that runs on Arizona sunshine? Elon Musk, the Chairman of this company, will take a shine to you for figuring this one out. Snap a picture of your group by the charger on the building and you will be "walking on the sun".

Bonus Clue 1 point Completed

Post a shot of the sunroof open on a Model S with the entire team standing up through it. Don't forget your signage!

Clue #14 0 points 8 minutes 2 miles Completed

Get in your rockets and prepare to activate your landing sequence as you have almost reached the end of your journey to the red planet. The launching pad was the first Tesla Service center and now after your journey you will be touching down at coordinates found here:
